Two days of instructional teaching and a workshop day for each artist will be hosted at the Pencil Museum.

26-28 September: Dorothy Ramsey

Dorothy is an expressive landscape artist inspired by the beautiful Cumbrian mountains. She likes to work in Derwent XL Charcoal/ Graphite and Graphitint ranges.



4-6 October: Karen Coulson

Karen specialises in detailed wild animal drawings and works in coloured pencil, using Derwent Artist Pencils, Coloursoft and the new Procolour Pencils. She is a self-taught professional Coloured Pencil Artist painting mostly wildlife subjects. She has been an artist in residence for many years at Derwent. Her workshop is a two and a half day course priced at £170.00 (8 places still available).



10-12 October: Alex Jakob-Whitworth

Alex works in mixed media but one of her favourite mediums is Derwent Inktense and Watercolour range. She will be working in this medium for her workshop.



17-19 October: Valerie Wood

Valerie works in graphite and mixed colour pencils, focusing her studies on the natural world and wildlife.
